ORDINANCE ADOPTED July 22, 1963

Solicitors, Hawkers, Peddlers

Fee \$25.00 for calendar year

Section 1. Definition of Solicitor

a. The term "solicitor" as used in this ordinance shall mean a person who goes from place to place or house to house taking or offering to take orders for the future delivery of goods, wares or merchandise, or for services to be performed in the future, or for making, manufacturing or repairing any article or thing whatever for future delivery. The term shall also include canvassers who go from house to house arranging or attempting to arrange subsequent meetings or interviews in behalf of solicitors or salesmen. The term shall not include salesmen calling on regular established customers of the salesman or his employer, and persons who have been expressly invited by the occupant to call at the house or other place to solicit such orders.

b. The term "hawker" shall mean and include a person standing or going about in any public street or public place who sells or offers for sale in such street or public place any goods, wares or merchandise including printed material. The term shall not include persons selling or offering to sell produce from their own farms or gardens.

Section 2. License Required

It shall be unlawful for any person, within the corporate limits of the City of Sherrill to act as a hawker or solicitor as herein defined without first having obtained and paid for, and having in force and effect a license therefor. Said license shall be issued by the City Clerk of the City of Sherrill and shall be in writing signed by said City Clerk, and the fee therefore shall be \$25.00 per calendar year. The Clerk shall not issue a license to any person who has been convicted of any crime or of the offense of disorderly conduct.

Section 3. Penalty for Violation

Any person who violates this ordinance shall be guilty of an offense punishable upon conviction by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars or imprisonment not more than thirty days or both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption by the City Commission and filing with the City Clerk. (Filing date: July 23, 1963)
