This has been an annual occurrence to help mitigate any undesirable Halloween activities in the parks.

SALE OF SURPLUS PROPERTY

B. Lovett reported that the auctions have closed on the pick-up trucks, former vactor and floor machine. The high bids were for the Power & Light truck (2018) \$43,500, Sewer truck (2013) \$25,100, Vactor \$3,850, and floor machine \$420. Lovett noted that the P&L truck was purchased for \$37,000 in 2018 and the 2013 truck was purchased for \$27,000. Motion was made by J. Shay and seconded by D. Hyle to accept the high bids.
