## **From the City Manager** **Brandon M. Lovett**

Spring has officially sprung, and we're excited for the Spring & Summer weather. All of the City's Recreation information including the Pool,

Summer Concerts and more will be available on the City's website, [sherrillrec.com](http://sherrillrec.com) and the upcoming Summer Fun Guide that should be out Late April, early May. If anyone is interested in becoming a lifeguard for the City of Sherrill, please contact Barry VanDreason in the Recreation Dept. We're always looking for guards.

Curbside green waste collection started April 10 and runs until October 23. Green waste collection takes place the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month. The 2023 calendar is on page 11. Sherrill Residents may also utilize the green waste drop off location at the DPW garage anytime. Contractors cannot utilize the DPW location. Contractors must contact Sherrill City Hall to schedule a dump time at the Waste Water Treatment Plant, and pay a \$15 disposal fee, or contractors can use one of Oneida Herkimer Solid Waste Authorities Eco Drop locations. In the Winter Newsletter we informed residents that bio-degradable bags would be required for curbside collection of grass clippings and the disposal rules have changed. Residents do not need bags and may dispose of grass clippings by placing them loosely curbside in a pile or in a container 35 gallons or less, with a weight of 40 lbs or less.

The Rt. 5 Corridor project design is completed and pending approval from the NYSDOT to be let out to bid. Construction is expected to start in Fall of 2023. The nearly \$8 million dollar Wastewater Treatment Plant is nearly complete. The finishing touches are expected to be completed by Summer.

The Oneida County Bridge that spans the Taylor Creek on W. Hamilton Ave. was reopened in December of 2022. The old bridge support on the East Side of the Creek is there temporarily to help support the gas line. According to National Grid the design of the bridge will not support the gas line so National Grid must directionally drill under the creek with a new gas line. This work was unexpected and is currently in the design phase. National Grid expects to install and construct the new line in the 2024 construction season.

The 2023 Fireworks/Concert will be held on July 29th. Musical act Darling and Dapper will open for Gridley Paige starting at 4pm. Food trucks, Copper City Brewery and much more will also be on hand.
