- Must be at least 21 years of age
- Must be of good moral character and able to pass a thorough background investigation

- Perform general police duties including patrol, traffic enforcement, and responding to calls for service
- Protect life and property, prevent crime, and maintain public order
- Prepare written reports, issue citations, and provide courtroom testimony
- Engage in community policing efforts and promote positive public relations
- Work independently and professionally with minimal supervision

- Possess excellent judgment, integrity, and communication skills
- Demonstrate knowledge of local, state, and federal laws
